CedarS Camps

CedarS is a not-for-profit camp for Christian Scientists, backed by a volunteer Board of Trustees, but still run by 2nd and 3rd generation members of its founding family, the Huffs. The 800-acre Ranch is ideally situated in the beautiful Ozark Hill Country atop an "uplifting plateau" over 1,000 feet higher than the surrounding plains. The Ozarks are blessed with spring-fed streams for canoeing and fishing, caves for exploring, lakes for skiing and sailing, and wooded hilltops for hiking, rappelling, and riding. This is a perfect place to explore, learn, retreat and network! Come join us for joyous time with your fellow Christian Science nurses!

Transportation

There are several choices for travel to the CedarS Camps (about 3 hours SW from St. Louis, Missouri). Go to the CedarS website at www.cedarscamps.org for more information on and directions to the camp itself.

First, you can drive directly to the camps.

Secondly, if you are flying, the St. Louis Lambert International (STL) Airport is the closest airport. When you arrive, you can either rent a car from the many choices at the airport and drive to the camps or you can take the CedarS eXpress chartered bus (\$40 each way). The CedarS eXpress will pick you up at the St. Louis airport on Wednesday and deliver you in air-conditioned comfort to CedarS Camp as well as return you to the airport on Sunday.

Be alert when booking your airline flights. In order to take advantage of the CedarS eXpress you MUST fly in before the 2PM time on Wednesday when the CedarS eXpress leaves and on Sunday your flight CANNOT leave before 2PM.

This is also a prime opportunity to visit the beautiful area in and around St. Louis before you join us for the Conference. Both Principia Upper School and Principia College are in the area along with many wonderful tourist attractions, like the famous St. Louis Arch! Come and enjoy!
