In September, the board met together in Albany, NY to begin planning for the 2015 International Christian Science Nursing Conference. The theme is "Serving in the newness of Spirit: Expanding our borders, Strengthening our base" (inspired by Romans 7:6 and S&H 430:6).

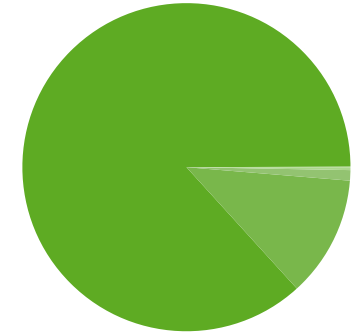
Love does

and satisfies.

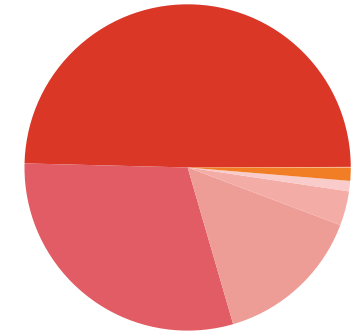
