It has been wonderful year of walking over many waves.

Our Annual Meeting in January was made possible via SKYPE.

In February we decided to temporarily suspend our publication, Vision Now!, to support The Mother Church website which has a community for Christian Science nurses. We did however publish a post Conference Vision Now! (Part 1), to share the wonderful activity of the 2011 International Christian Science Nursing Conference.

This was the year for our 9th International Christian Science Nursing Conferences! It was held at CedarS Camp in early September and the theme was "Walking over the Wave". We spent many joyful hours on SKYPE calls planning the 2011 ICSNC. Our board worked to get grants to support the Conference and assistance for Christian Science nurses to attend.

We were lovingly "nursed" by Warren, Gay, Kathy and CedarS staff. Approximately 80 Christian Science nurses attended. There were individuals from across the US, England, Canada, Australia, Switzerland, and for the first time, France and South Africa. An international flair was present in our discussions and workshop demonstrations – offering many opportunities to expand our understanding of Christian Science nursing.

For the first time at our Conferences, we were able to offer honorariums, housing reimbursement, and travel support to all of our presenters. We were also able to lower our conference fee for all attendees from \$350 to \$325, due in large part to the funds granted to CSNN by Foundations. We were able to offer benevolence for Christian Science nurse attendees for travel, housing and conference fees. It

was indeed a Conference that enabled us to walk over wave(s).

We rejoice in God's direction as we progress and look forward to the coming year.

Katherine Pennington retired from the CSNN board last year. Before moving onward, she gently, graciously, and most lovingly transitioned the treasurer's books.

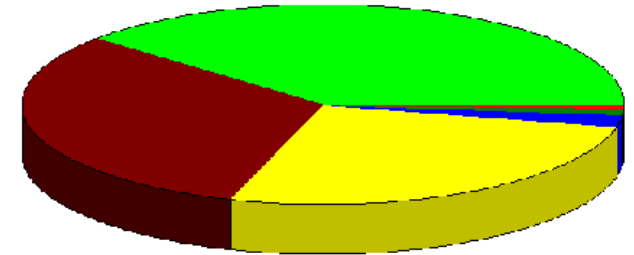

I'll close this year's report with words from Mrs. Eddy found in Miscellany that have been echoing in my thought this year; "Love unfolds marvelous good..."

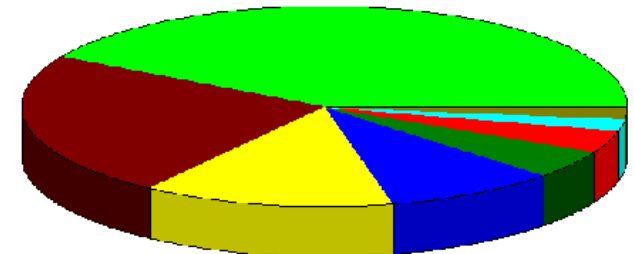
