It has been a wonderful year of being "Taught of God" (John 6:45 taught).

Our Annual Meeting in January was made possible via SKYPE.

This was the year of our International Christian Science Nursing Conference! It was held at CedarS Camp in early September. Our theme was "All taught of God". We spent many joyful hours on SKYPE calls planning the 2013 ICSNC. Our board worked to get grants to support the conference and assistance for Christian Science nurses to attend to the Conference.

We again were lovingly "nursed" by Warren, Gay, Kathy and the CedarS staff. Approximately 110 persons attended. There were individuals from across the US, England, Australia, Switzerland, and South Africa. An international flair was present in our discussions and workshop demonstrations – offering many opportunities to expand our understanding of Christian Science nursing. The Board of Directors of The Mother Church attended the first few days, speaking with us and providing a very special highlight of the conference.

Again at this Conference, we were able to offer honorariums, housing reimbursement, and travel support to all of our presenters. We were also able to keep our conference fee for all attendees at \$325, due in large part to the funds granted to CSNN by Foundations. We were able to offer benevolence for Christian Science nurse attendees for travel, housing and conference fees.

invisible. *We must see it.*


We must give
