## Transportation

When considering how to get to CedarS Camps, options include:

1. Driving directly to the camp
2. Flying into the St. Louis (STL) airport and renting a car OR signing up for the free CedarS eXpress bus for the 3-hour trip to camp
3. Flying into Springfield (SGF) airport and renting a car to drive about an hour to camp

**IMPORTANT:** In order to ride the CedarS eXpress, your flight **MUST** arrive in St. Louis before the bus departs at 2PM on Wednesday. Your flight out **CANNOT** leave before 2PM on Sunday.

# 2017 INTERNATIONAL CHRISTIAN SCIENCE NURSING CONFERENCE

## Registration

Registration is divided into two parts, both **opening June 1 and closing on August 25**. We are happy to announce that the conference fee remains the same as 2015, but with no late registration penalty!

**Part 1:** To register and pay for the conference (\$300) [click here](#).

**BEFORE** you make your accommodation reservations with CedarS Camps, please pay or make dependable arrangements for your conference registration fee to be paid.

**Part 2:** To register and pay for CedarS accommodations [click here](#) after you have completed your conference registration. Choose one of the special all-inclusive packages.

- **Plan A / \$275:** includes all meals & 4 nights in a shared, screened-in cabin with in-cabin dormitory-style bath (you may be assigned or request up to 5 roommates). \$75 each additional day.
- **Plan B / \$325:** includes all meals & 4 nights in a shared, air-conditioned room with bath (you may be assigned or request up to 3 to 4 roommates). \$90 each additional day.
- **Plan C / \$350:** includes all meals & 4 nights in a shared, air-conditioned room with bath (you may be assigned or request 1 roommate.) \$110 each additional day.
- **Plan D / \$425:** includes all meals & 4 nights in a private air-conditioned room with private bath. Sorry, no additional days are available.

Private AC rooms are limited and available first come, first served.
