In February, two of our officers, Kim Thorndike and Mary Hollister, attended the Philanthropy Forum meeting in St. Louis to share the results of the survey the Christian Science Nursing Network (CSNN) facilitated. The survey collected information from Christian Science nurses regarding their practice. The purpose of this survey was to evaluate ways the Philanthropy Forum might provide support for the sustainability of Christian Science nursing. It was a joyous meeting and we were grateful to be a part of it.

In the spring, Kerry Reed and Patricia Brugioni stepped off the board. We are grateful for her years of service. Alistair Budd was appointed to the board just in time to assist with the conference. Hollis Tiger Wines joined the board in November.

The 2017 ICSNC was held at CedarS CampS September 6-10th. The theme was "One By-Law, One Christian Science Nurse". 

are in a sound financial position for moving forward with our work in 2018 and your continued support is not only needed but immeasurably appreciated!


