CSNN engaged the same CPA who specializes in non-profits to prepare the 2014 tax return, file the charity registration renewal, and perform the review. He reported that no problems were found with our books.

We were grateful to plan the 2015 ICSNC knowing that we were free from incurring any personal financial liability for our board members. Through the strong and committed support of our donors, the organization maintains a reserve fund large enough to cover conference planning. This enabled us to prayerfully focus on the theme and content of the conference more fully without undue financial concerns. In addition, we were able to modestly lower the conference registration fee and cover the cost of bus transportation to and from the St. Louis airport for the attendees.

It was also our joy this year to launch the *Notices & News* program. This quarterly electronic communication provides a venue for individuals and organizations to share information with the individual Christian Science nurse through our mailing list. Announcements, job openings, training schedules, etc. may be shared. This service is offered to our field at no charge. However, donations have been generous and are most gratefully received.

2015 was a wonderful year, full of progress.

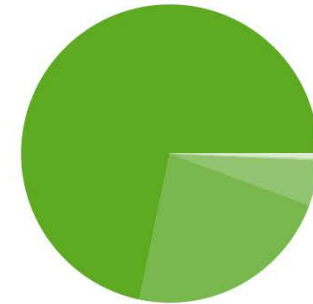

We rejoice in God’s direction as the organization progresses and look forward to the coming year!

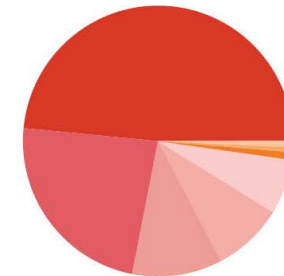
