## **CedarS Camps**

CedarS is a not-forprofit camp for Christian Scientists, backed by a volunteer Board of Trustees, but still run by 2nd and 3rd generation members of its founding family, the Huffs. Situated in the beautiful Ozark Hill Country atop an "uplifting plateau" over 1000 feet higher than the surrounding plains, it encompasses 800 acres. This area in Missouri is blessed with spring-fed streams for canoeing, and fishing, caves for exploring, lakes for skiing and sailing, and wooded hilltops for hiking, repelling and riding. It is a perfect place to retreat, explore, learn and network. Come join a joyfilled adventure, be nursed by the wonderful CedarS staff and network with fellow Christian Science nurses.

CedarS offers an allinclusive package of housing and meals for all attending the Conference.

## Housing

CedarS has FOUR choices for housing which include all meals:

A. Shared cabin (assigned or request up to 5 roommates) with dormitory style baths.

- B. Shared (assigned or request 2-3 roommates) a/c room with private bath.
- C. Shared (assigned or request one roommate) a/c room with private bath.
- D. Private a/c room with private bath.

## **Recreational Activity**

Recreational resources and activities which will be available for your use 2-3 hours per day or evening: the 300 ft. waterslide, lap pool and diving well with 2-3 lifeguards on duty; 40 ft. climbing



wall & gym with 1-2 facilitators on duty; equipment to fish, paddle, boat or canoe at Crown Lake; balls and Frisbees, and tennis equipment,

Bermuda-grass soccer field, covered (lighted) basketball court, ping pong and foosball



tables, grass volleyball court, capture the flag mesa; trampolines; a couple of study rooms with bound volumes and computer access; plus an 850 acre nature reserve with miles of hiking trails and creeks to explore; and much more including the new Bible Lands Park.

## **Transportation**

There are several choices for travel to the CedarS Camps (about 3 hours SW of St. Louis, Missouri). Go to the CedarS website at: <a href="https://www.cedarscamps.org">www.cedarscamps.org</a> for more information on and directions to CedarS.

You can drive directly to CedarS.

If you are flying, the St. Louis Lambert International (STL) Airport and the Springfield-**Branson National Airport** (KSGF) are the closest airports. When you arrive, you can rent a car from the numerous choices at the airport and drive to the camps or **from STL** (St. Louis Lambert International) you can take the CedarS eXpress chartered bus (\$40 each way). The CedarS express will pick you up at the St. Louis Airport on Wednesday and deliver you in air-conditioned comfort to CedarS as well as return you to the airport on Sunday.

To take advantage of the CedarS eXpress, you MUST arrive at STL airport before 2PM on Wednesday and your Sunday flight CANNOT leave before 2PM.

If arriving early, consider sightseeing in St. Louis or visiting Principia College and/or Principia Upper School.
